Morning COPP Classes

***Introduction to the Bible – Course #1001, Phase 1 Requirement**

***The Synoptic Gospels – Course #1075, Phase 2 Requirement**

Course Objective: Study of the person and work of the Holy Spirit. A thorough look at the corresponding doctrines that influence our understanding of the work of the Holy Spirit. ***Organizing the Church for Christian Education- Course #6013, Phase 4 Requirement**

Course Objective: Focus on the various administrative and organizational skills needed to organize the Christian education department. Emphasis placed on structure, leadership, and staffing needs for Christian education.
